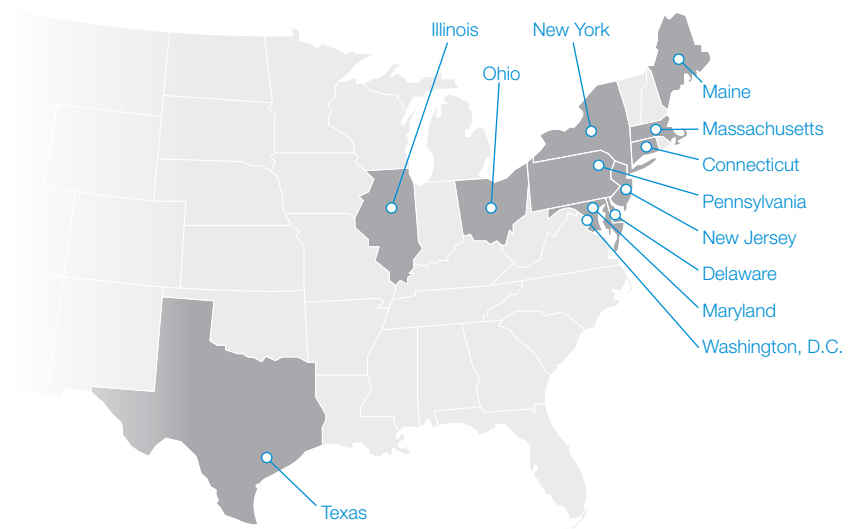

GDF SUEZ Energy Resources Growth Milestones

2002

July. New United States retail energy business established as Tractebel Energy Services.

October. Tractebel Energy Services takes first steps toward becoming a national energy supplier entering MA, NY, PA and TX markets.

2003

March. Tractebel Energy Services licensed in ME, increasing presence to five states.

August. Tractebel Energy Services enters NJ, now serving six states.

2004

April. Tractebel Energy Services licensed in MD, increasing service to seven states.

August. Tractebel Energy Services ranked sixth largest REP by KEMA.

2005

January. Tractebel Energy Services enters Washington, D.C., increasing presence to seven states and the nation’s capitol.

April. Tractebel Energy Services begins doing business as SUEZ Energy Resources NA.

June. SUEZ Energy Resources licensed in IL, increasing presence to eight states and Washington, D.C.

2007

March. SUEZ Energy Resources enters CT and DE, increasing presence to 10 states and Washington, D.C.

2008

July. SUEZ and Gaz de France merge creating a world energy leader, GDF SUEZ.

2009

June. SUEZ Energy Resources NA begins doing business as GDF SUEZ Energy Resources NA.

2011

May. GDF SUEZ Energy Resources NA enters the Ohio market.

December. Launched Think Energy brand to target small commercial and industrial customers with loads less than 0.5 MW.

2012

December. Launch partnership with Viridity Energy to expand service offerings to include demand response, utility demand management, and usage optimization.

2013

October. Investment in One Roof Energy, solar provider, further expands GDF SUEZ Energy Resources set of customer solutions.

2014

January. Think Energy enters Pennsylvania residential market.

Known for a value added approach GDF SUEZ brings the same global leadership in power expertise we are known for overseas and in the mature energy market states to the local Ohio marketplace.

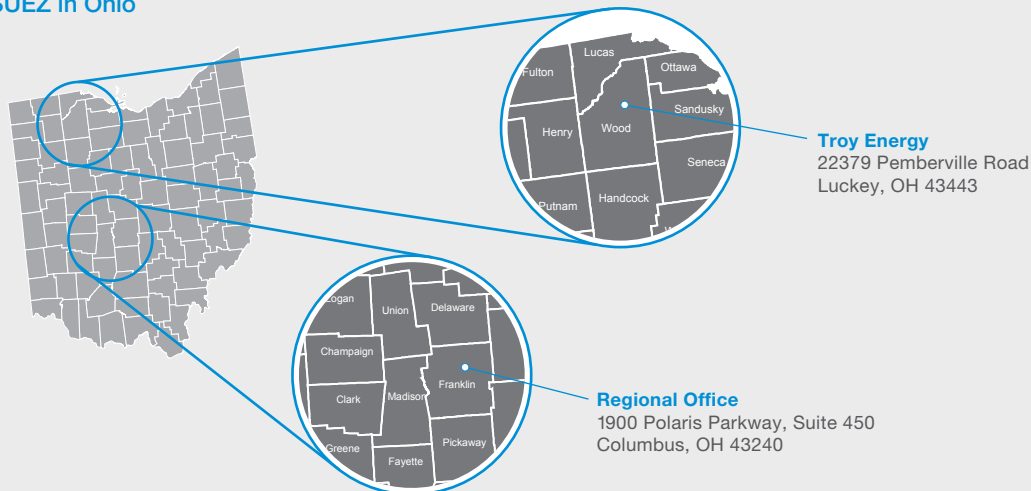
Troy Energy (Luckey, OH)
