The RECs provided by ENGIE Resources will have a measurable impact on greenhouse gas emissions. According to a calculator from the Environmental Protection Agency, the RECs are equivalent to the carbon sequestered by 132,501 tree seedlings grown for 10 years, removing about 5,113 metric tons of CO₂ from the atmosphere, or to the displacement of the estimated annual greenhouse gas emissions of 1,080 passenger vehicles driven for one year.
