That's the foundation of Tarkett's sustainability efforts. With one of the largest portfolios of flooring and sports solutions in the world, the company aims to make a considerable impact when it comes to environmental responsibility.

Since 2016, ENGIE has supported Tarkett's strategy, supplying renewable energy certificates (RECs) to offset the carbon emissions of the company's North American headquarters and manufacturing sites in Ohio. For three years, the company added an estimated 30 million kWh of demand to the marketplace for carbonneutral energy generation.

In August 2019, Tarkett began receiving physical green supply from a nearby wind farm through a renewal agreement with ENGIE to power nine sites. The deal also included national Green-e® certified RECs to further support the development of renewable assets.

By 2025, Tarkett will have procured 230,908 RECs, demonstrating considerable strength in low-carbon leadership and a significant display in carbon offset. The impact will be equivalent to the emissions from, displaced, or sequestered by the following:
