GDF SUEZ SUBSIDIARY SCHEDULES INSTRUCTIONAL WEBINAR TO ASSIST BUSINESS AND INSTITUTIONAL CUSTOMERS IN PENELEC AND MET-ED SERVICE TERRITORIES TO PREPARE FOR ELECTRICITY COMPETITION
